In the 12th century, Rabbi Mosheh ben Maimon (Maimonides, 1138–1204) wrote in his work Mishneh Torah (Hilchot Anijim 8): "There is no greater mitzvah than the ransom of abductees." An old prayer from the Siddur:


Our Jewish brothers, our Jewish sisters, who were plunged into suffering, in suffering and imprisonment between sea and mainland.

Rally: Demonstration against the Far Right!

On February 10th, 11:00 a.m.–12:30 p.m., a demonstration will take place in front of the wedding house at Hamelner Markt, which will be directed against the rise of right-wing extremist forces. A broad coalition of institutions and organizations in Hameln is organizing this rally. Here is your call to participate in large numbers.

Limmud Rabbah

This year, the Shiurim of Limmud Rabbah, led by Rabbi Ulrike Offenberg, are dedicated to the study of the Megillot and special text readings of the Jewish holidays. We will now study the book of Esther until Purim, and this is a rare opportunity to get to know this story in more detail. In the clatter and noise of Purim celebrations, the subtleties of this ornate text are often lost. This time we will look in detail at the historical background of this Megillah, its structure, its special features and its profound humor.

JLEV Shabbaton

On the weekend 1st–3rd in March our community will host the JLEV Shabbaton. JLEV stands for Jewish Liberal-Egalitarian Association, the association of liberal communities founded last year under the umbrella of the Central Council of Jews in Germany. In addition, the rabbi of our sister community in Hanover, Alex Kovtun, and the chairwoman of the General Rabbinical Conference, Rabbi Prof. Dr. Elisa Klapheck, will be involved in services and lead shiurim.
